MEMORANDUM)

T O : ALL MEMBERS

Please be informed that our association will have its first general meeting on March 17 at seven o'clock in the evening. This will be held at the St. Knud's School Gymnasium at Stenosgade 4A.

The agenda for this general meeting are as follows:

1. Amendment of the Constitution - Our present constitution has some provisions which need to be reviewed and amended to bring it to a more practical level. During the meeting we will discuss how we should go about with the amendment work, i.e., selection of persons to do the work and other matters concerning our constitution.
2. Loan Agreement with Bank - We have just finalized an arrangement with one of the banks here in Copenhagen wherein members of the FAD, who are in financial needs, are eligible to secure a loan upon endorsement of our association. We should like to have your opinions and suggestions on what precautionary measures we can undertake to insure that members securing said loans can meet their obligations faithfully so as not to mar the name of our association.
3. Charter Flight - We have already made final arrangements for a cheap charter flight to the Philippines for this coming Christmas. Mr. Gaudie Caluza, who is in-charge of this project, would announce the details of the trip during the meeting. We should like to discuss with you some points which need a general opinion, especially the mode of payment for the fare so as not to burden members who are interested in joining the trip home.
4. Monthly Dues - Our Constitution has a provision for monthly dues of DK5.00 but the collection of said dues has been very ineffective. To bolster our treasury so we can meet financial needs for future projects of the F.A.D., we would like to impose this collection. However, without your full cooperation we would not be able to push through with it successfully so we would like to have your full approval before we start collecting and we will know this during the meeting.
5. Independence Day Celebration - As June 12 would soon be just around the corner, we would like to discuss with you if you would still be interested to have a celebration of our independence day in spite of the fact that our country is under martial law.
