

PAGKAKAISANG PILIPINO AWARD

To give credit, honor and gratitude to those who have dedicated and unselfishly rendered their time, efforts and services for the well being of the Filipino Association of Denmark and the Filipino community as a whole; to encourage members to participate more actively in the affairs of the Association and non-members to join the same, this program is hereby conceived and designed.

WHEREAS, the Award which was originally called The Outstanding Members Award shall be named "Pagkakaisang Pilipino Award", such name given by His Excellency Jose Manuel Stilianopoulos, Philippine Ambassador to Great Britain during the initial presentation in 1980.

WHEREAS, the presentation of the Pagkakaisang Pilipino Award shall be biennial.

WHEREAS, any bonafide member maybe nominated provided he/she:

- 1. is not holding any elective position at the time of nomination;
- has a permanent residence in Denmark;
 officially nominated by any member of the community.

WHEREAS, the screening of candidates or nominees shall be according to:

- 1. Accomplishments
- 2. Services
- 3. Loyalty and Cohesiveness
- 4. Participation in the activities of the Association
- 5. Financial voluntary contribution and donation
- 6. Concern for the community

WHEREAS, the fields of activities for this award shall be:

- 1. Sports
- 2. Social Activity
- 3. Community Service
- 4. Philippine Cultural Promotion
- 5. Creative Involvement
- 6. Education

WHEREAS, the definition and criteria of the above fields of activities are:

- 1. SPORTS covers all forms of recreation recognized by the FAD to generate friendship and unity among members and non-members and means of promoting the name not only of the Filipino Association of Denmark but also of the Philippines. The Award shall be given to any player or organizer who have shown exemplary interest and with a remarkable standing in sportsmanship.
- 2. SOCIAL ACTIVITY has to do with active participation and involvement in group situations requiring dealings with one another such as social consciousness, social reform and social problems.
- 3. COMMUNITY SERVICE is the voluntary service rendered to any individual and or to the Association in time of moral, social and financial needs/ distress without remuneration of any form.
- 4. PHILIPPINE CULTURAL PROMOTION covers the promotion of Philippine Folk Dance, Folk Songs, Products and Language wherein services rendered are purely voluntary and uncompensated.

- 5. CREATIVE INVOLVEMENT is a contribution of an artistic or intellectual inventiveness. Ability to create anything original i.e. literaries, arts and constructive ideas which if given or imparted to the Association for its benefit, shall be FAD property and shall not be paid in any form.
- 6. EDUCATION This Award will be given to a member or to any child of a bonafide member who is currently pursuing his/her studies and has remarkable scholastic standing or has successfully attained the highest level of education in Denmark.

WHEREAS, after screening, six finalists shall be chosen in line with the abovementioned field of activities.

WHEREAS, THE MOST DISTINGUISHED MEMBER OF THE YEAR can also be chosen among the six finalists provided he/she has:

- 1. special achievement/s which is beneficial to the community or to the Association, or
- 2. exemplary attainment, or
- 3. original creation of something unique that need extra-ordinary capability and efficiency, or
- 4. received an award of recognition from any institution or international civic organization.

WHEREAS, the funding of this program will come from donations solicited for this specific purpose, whereby all unused amount will be time deposited in a bank and will only be withdrawn during the period for the next award.

WHEREAS, each of the awardees shall receive the following prizes:

- 1. FAD Certificate of Award
- 2. FAD Medal or Trophy
- 3. Gift items from sponsors

WHEREAS, the Most Distinguished Member of the Year shall receive the Trophy conferred by the Philippine Embassy in London or by His Excellency The Ambassador, and extra prizes solicited for this purpose.

WHEREAS, the panel of judges shall compose of a chairman and four members, which shall be appointed by the President from any of the FAD officers or any member of the Association considered to be fair and just who is most familiar with members of the community.

THEREFORE, this program is designed exclusively for giving awards and certificate of appreciation to deserving members of the Association and the Filipino community in Denmark.

FURTHERMORE, the general fund of the Filipino Association of Denmark shall not in any way be used for this purpose.



Progress Report

PREFACE

When I was elected president of the Association four years ago, I had a mixed feeling of joy and anxiety. Joy in a sense that I won a hotly contested election and anxiety over the awesome responsibility accounted to me then.

Upon hindsight I realized that, inspite of the many trials, problems and challenges that had confronted me through the years,

I have come out battle stricken yet true and humble.

We are of course fortunate enough to have three consul-generals over the last four years who have given our community excellent support. I have the fortune to work with Consul General Hjalmar Ibsen who inducted me into office in my first term, Christian R. Hunderup in my second term and now Thorkild Erritzøe who is currently attending to the needs of our immigrant community. This experienced has been fruitful and rewarding not only to me but also to the entire Filipino community.

Following is a brief sum-up of the Association's achievements

in the last four years under my term of office:

The Filipino Association of Denmark in its great desire to unite and help every willing member of the Filipino community living in Denmark has been actively participating in all beneficial

endeavors it could give a hand to.

In consular affairs, it has been busy assisting the office of the Consulate General attend to specific matters of importance to the community. This have ranged from the publication of consular and governmental announcements through the monthly infos, to the less pleasant and more complex task of assisting Filipino nationals solve specific problems with their employers and other Filipinos with different types of problems which best not to be elaborated, to the pleasure and honor of helping the Consulate attend to guests from the Philippine Government and from other foreign missions. A case to recall was the reception arranged for the delegates to the World's Women Congress held in Copenhagen in 1980 and headed by no other than the First Lady.

In economics, the Association has been in the forefront of soliciting funds through many ways. Funds acquired has helped many FAD members and non-members alike in times of their financial necessities. The biggest expenditure of the Association however goes to the regular publication and mailing of the infos, Newsletters and diverse souvenir programs which abreast members of the goings-

on in their community.

By the end of this year when the financial report is to be finalized, the Association's net cash is expected to reach approximately Dkr. 11,000.00 compared to 1978 balance of Dkr. 5,000.00. For a non-profit organization as the FAD such an amount may well be considered a good if not excellent standing.

The Association is socially minded too. Traditional Filipino gatherings like Valentine Party, the Independence Celebration and the Christmas Party had been yearly organized to acquaint one ano-

ther especially the new comers and those living outside Copenhagen. At the same time distinguished members or those who exemplary served the Association are acknowledged. In fact, on this year's celebration of Christmas there will for the second time again be a presentation of Certificates of Appreciation and Awards to deserv-

ing members.

The affair of the youth, is a thing the Association is much concerned. It promoted and safeguarded their welfare by encouraging them to participate more deeply in the activities of the Association. It sponsored them to join the Danish Basketball Leagues, and rented for them a gym to practice. It gave them chances to be members of its cultural arms: the Filipino Dance Troupe of Copenhagen and the Perlas ng Silangan, a choral group. Even the children of eleven years and below have a special day of love and care given them by their parent's Association. That is the Children Christmas Party where proceeds of the FAD carolling is spent for.

In 1980, the FAD inspired by its good members that keep increasing, tried to find a common place to gather. Fortunately we had Father Patrick Sheils around and with his help a portion of the Skt. Annæ Church Annex was awarded by the bishopric and the parish to the Association to be the Filipino Pastoral Center. Inspired by the place and location, members donated furnitures and the FAD bought vital equipments and properties needed. But with a total asset of around Dkr. 35,000.00 somewhere something went wrong. So presently the Association is trying hard to obtain subsidy from the Danish Ministry of Interior for a hall of its own. Hopefully, it is to receive a favorable response by the early part of the incoming year.

It would be hyprocricy to think that the Association has all ups and no downs. Like all kinds of society, difficulties and problems are parts of their growth. The FAD is no exemption at all. Unfortunately the Association cannot please everybody, of course it is impossible to please everybody as everyone has his own personal wistfulness. In this score reciprocal understanding is so antici-

patedly desired.

As was in the years bygone the Filipino Association of Denmark will in the future continue to represent the Filipinos in Denmark. It will at all times endeavor to earn that respect by seriuosly and faithfully shoudering the tremendous task bestowed upon it.
