



#### CHRISTMAS MESSAGE

"How is it going?" we ask a friend. "Going my way?" we inquire of a traveller.
"Going, going, gone," shouts the auctioneer. But no sooner do we get going into a new
Advent-Christmas season than we realise that the direction has been reversed. The emphasis of this season is not on GOING but on COMING.

The Coming of Our Lord Jesus. The opening prayers of our liturgies invite and encourage us to take "Christ's coming seriously." Therefore, we ask our all-powerful God to strengthen us so that "Christ may find an eager welcome at His coming".

The readings of these days reminds us that "The days are coming" when the Lord will fulfil his promises. Paul prays for his people that the Lord will strengthen their hearts and make them blameless and holy "at the coming of our Lord Jesus." Jesus himself proclaims that we will see "the Son of Man coming on a cloud with great power and glory."

Going shopping, going to parties, going... Given this obvious switch from going to coming, we need to take another look at our preparations for the coming of Christ at Christmas. Will the next three weeks find us going Christmas shopping, going from Christmas concert to Christmas party, going slightly mad as we try to keep up with the frantic pace of the Christmas rush?

Where is the coming in all this going, going, gone? Where is the quiet, reflective, prayerful time we need to recognise our emptiness that must be filled with God's fullness, to see our sinfulness that must be healed with God's forgiveness, to admit our loneliness that must be soothed with God's loving, living presence?

If we keep up our compulsive pre-Christmas pace and seldom or never take the time to simply wait for the Lord to come and to minister our needs, it is no wonder that Christmas leaves us breathless, disappointed, and questioning whether it was worth all the effort.

Our God Comes to Us. The message of Advent (the word itself means "coming") reveals to us the essential mystery of God's plan. Since we cannot come to God, God comes to us. That Good News gives us the reason for our Advent-Christmas posture of being ready and waiting -- "Stand up straight and raise your heads, for you ransom is near at hand."

As you prepare to celebrate the coming of Jesus on His birthday, celebrate His coming to you in every act of love and goodness in your lives. I therefore wish each of you, the FAD, our community, and friends a blessed (Christ-filled) Christmas and a New Year filled with expectation and joy.
