





It is not an almanac of the FAD though it provides many valuable accounts about it. Neither is it the ordinary special souvenir program, nor is it the quarterly FAD Info though it does contain a generous helping of those.

Instead, Silver Lining draws something from the impulse behind each of these ideas in its effort to involve the community readers in the great and not-so-great events in the life of The Filipino Association of Denmark.

This book employs all the limited journalistic tools available at the FAD Info's command. Its greater length and freer format allow for a more lavish display of pictures and for essays whose reach encompasses the association's entire life.

The materials in this book are created specifically for its pages. Taking the silver anniversary's special souvenir program as its starter, this book leads off with BECOMING, a sweeping yet detailed chronicle of the major issues and activities of the association's past twenty-five years. It also features a glimpse of all other Filipino clubs and organizations here in Denmark, and it further serves as an opportunity for business advertisements, personal greetings, announcements and the like.

Silver Lining cannot claim itself as a remarkable journalistic exploration of the FAD. But its editors hope it provides the community an orderly and exciting presentation of the events and they promise to increase its value in the years to come.






Consulate General of the Philippines Copenhagen

One day, a nurse and priest went to visit an isolated village of Peru. There they found a family living in extreme poverty and their daughter of 12 was very ill. There was no furniture in one-room house. The sick daughter was lying on the floor, wrapped only in her thin well-worn clothing. A very worried, illiterate mother pleaded for help. The nurse immediately gathered some wood to make a fire in order to heat up the cold room. Next she opened a thermos bottle of warm soup, which she had brought with her, and began to feed the sick girl. Then she heated water and bathed the girl very gently and lovingly. Afterwards she wrapped the girl in a blanket she had brought with her. For nearly half a day she took care of the sick girl. When this was done, the priest knelt and prayed with her and gave her the Eucharist. As the nurse and priest were about to leave, the girl wrapped in her new blanket raised herself up on the floor and said: "Today, God has been good to me!"




THE FILIPINO ASSOCIATION OF DENHARK IN COMMUNITY BUILDING

Marc. R. Dicay and Deng A. Valera

The Filipino Association of Denmark turns 25 this year. Benigno Adriatico's term and the other in 1992 under Marc. And as it celebrates this historic milestone, the FAD looks back to the two and a half decades of service with pride and a deep sense of accomplishment.


The Beginning

The Filipino Association of Denmark has humble beginnings. Its roots and its dramatic surge to community leadership could be traced back to the late 60s when Denmark, the small yet promising generous land of the Danes, opened her shore to foreign employment. A handful of Filipinos in search for better life migrated in and generated the growth of a tiny community. Upon the advice of the then Consul General



of the Philippines, Hon. Hjalmar Ibsen, the minute community organized themselves into a listening post in 1970 to help each other and their newly arrived countrymen. This listening post became the nucleus that subsequently developed into the first Filipino organization here, the Filipino Association of Denmark.


The FAD, as it is shortly called, had the elections of its charter officers on 21 March of the same year. Aproniano Soliven, the association's founder, was elected president.



To solidify the association, Aproniano Soliven and Antonio Garcia, first charter president and vice-president respectively, co-authored the constitution, the first draft of which was said to be written over two cups of coffee at the Copenhagen central station. True or not,

the time it was first amended in 1979. From there, the constitution underwent two revisions, one in 1990 under

R. Dicay's administration.







The newly-formed association was registered number the constitution proved to be effective until 3072 with the Forenings-Registeret in Copenhagen as a non-profit, non-political and service-oriented organization with Gladsaxe as its seat right after the constitution had been

framed. The approval was granted on 7 June 1971.

In its first three years of existence, the FAD's charge was a community of approximately 200 Filipinos who had mixed feeling of loneliness and togetherness. The calendar was nothing but social functions: Valentine's Party, Pista sa Nayon, Independence Day and Christmas



The Office

The FAD had never been housed permanently during the first nine years of its operations. The first congregation place was the Jesu Hjerte church in Stenosqude with Fr. Knud Nielsen as the Filipinos' spiritual counsellor. As the population increased, the community was blessed to have Fr. Patrick Sheils, CSsR, Chaplain for the Filipino community; Fr. Carroll Parker, OMI, Chaplain for the English-speaking community, Sr. Pilar Wijangco and Sr. Ana Maria Melocoton of the Assumption Convent as additional advisers.







There were also instances when the residence of the incumbent president became the association's locale and postal address for business, a practice that in one way or another limited its efficiency. But with the intermediary of Bishop Hans Mortensen in 1979, the FAD got its first official locale, Skt. Annæ church's annex building which also served as the pastoral center for Filipino children.

After a while, the office was transferred in the same vicinity along Amagerbrogade. In 1989, Consul General Arne Simonsen allowed the association to use without any liability

one of his business offices situated at the center of Copenhagen. From then on up to the present, the office at



Åboulevard 10, now equipped with a copying machine, personal computer, telephone and fax machine to cater the community with better service, has served as the official domicile of the Filipino Association of Denmark.



The Coffer

It the time of inception, the FAD barely had enough funds to survive and to function effectively. Nevertheless, it did. It grew and strengthened. It is richer now and consequently, it is functioning more efficiently, placing its once immature self into a stable and more secure standing and making itself the oldest organization here in Denmark and in the whole Scandinavian region.

Through its tread, the FAD maintains its financial pace mainly through collection of membership dues and solicitation of donations and advertisements. Many times in the past, the officers innovated varied and interesting social functions that yielded the supplementary funds needed to finance the association's projects. These activities which satisfy the needs of the community are retained and are now being observed yearty.



The Milestones

uring the two and a half decades that the FAD existed, it can lay claims to numerous significant accomplishments, particularly on the aspect of infrastructure development and promotion of domestic service and culture.

The Dance Troupe. One masterpiece that any Filipino would love to show the world is a variety of our folk dances, an entertainment combined with fashion that was



born ages before the invention of stereo, minus one, karaoke and laser spotlights. This artistic form of entertainment has been passed on from one generation to another.



The Filipino Dance Troupe of Copenhagen, the first dance group organized by Prescilla Neri in 1972, underwent a reorganization process in 1980 under the rigorous supervision of Rufina Decano.

Inspired by its significance, Jennifer Stilling formed in 1987 another group, the *Maharlika* Dance Troupe, and carried on the lead.



The FAD Folkloric Dance Troupe entered the scene in 1991. Well-directed and choreographed by Benigno Adriatico, the dancers amused the audience with their interpretation of Philippine folk dances in a variety of colorful costumes. Now, they do not only cater to the internal affairs of the association, but they are occasionally invited to perform with remuneration in private parties and official functions of other Danish organizations, much to the delight of the parents and the dancers.




The FAD Song. Nineteen-eighty was another significant year for the association, for this year tuned-in an anthem. Inspired by Amicitia and Unitas, the two guiding principles of the FAD, John Blix and Oscar Trinidad composed the lyrics of the FAD Song and had the notes arranged by Resty Toribio, a long-time friend of John Blix. The newly composed theme song was sung publicly for the first time during the eighty-second anniversary celebration of Philippine independence. It was sung again during the

Salusalo Night '94, the first reunion of all the FAD officers.

The Chorale Group. The association's social affairs during the 70s and the 80s featured among other things the





FAD Chorale Group, the *Perlas ng Silangan* chorale group and the *Harana* Singers. Ably coordinated and led by guitar



virtuoso Oscar Trinidad, the three singing groups rendered their own interpretations of classical and modern Philippine music to the amusement of the attending guests.

The *Pista ng Nayon*. Coming from the different regions of the country, the members of the Filipino community could very well hold their own regional festivities. But in the spirit of friendship and unity, the FAD launches an annual *Pista sa Nayon* to promote Philippine culture, and at the same time to generate funds for its other operational expenses.



The event which is usually indoors kicks off with an exposition of a variety of Filipino specialties and traditional

fiesta dishes for sale. In between the day's festivity are raffle draws where big and small prizes, courtesy of some generous sponsors and donors, are at stake. Native folk dances are performed with song intermission numbers by some young talents of the community.



For the first time, a two-day *Pista ng Nayon* was held outdoors at the Islands Brygge *havn* in 1993 in coordination with the *Dansk Bryggens Kulturalforening*. Every other year, the affair serves as an opportunity for the FAD to present the different candidates running for elections.

The RP Delegates. In July 1980, an enthusiastic flag-bearing crowd of FAD members assembled at Copenhagen



airport to meet Mrs. Imelda Marcos, chairman of the Philippine delegation to the United Nations Women Conference held at the Bella Center.

"I came to Denmark, first to meet the Filipinos and second to attend the World Summit for Social Development." With these heart-warming intro spiel, President Fidel V. Ramos, who joined more than 100 heads of states in the historic United Nations summit conference held in Copenhagen, addressed the Filipino communities in Scandinavia in a meeting hosted for him at SAS Falconer Hotel in March 1995.

Describing his visit as a "Filipino summit" during the said momentous meeting, he recognized the valuable efforts



of the Filipinos abroad in contributing to the socio-economic growth of the country and acknowledged the OCWs as "Our Contribution to the World."

Miss Philippines-Europe. The FAD officers and members joined effort to host the Miss Philippines-Denmark, the first ever of its kind in the history of the Filipino



community. Catherine Bayangos Lauritsen who won the coveted title was crowned during the 95th anniversary of Philippine independence.

Following a display of ravishing beauty, exceptional talent and a wonderful blend of Filipino and European poise,



beauteous and regal Catherine bested nine other candidates and became the first title holder of *Miss Philippines-Europe* in a

beauty pageant held at London Hippodrome in November 1993, thus etching another record in the history of the FAD.

Sports. Sporting is a very healthy Pastime activity where the Objective is not only to win over but to Relax, as well as to Treat the opponent, not as a rival but as a Sportive pal. This is what sports is for. Sports activities play a significant role in people's life so these have been a major concern of the FAD. It maybe said that sports had its high points under Benjamin B. Garcia's term.

Basketball had been initiated by Benjamin B. Garcia way back 1976. It was a pity that the basketball team did not survive one tournament series. They made a good showing



until the well-known unfortunate incident. In 1980, he formed again two teams to compete with the Danish teams, namely the FAD Senior Team and the FAD Junior Team with



Gerry Torres and Willy Navarro as team captains respectively. Due to some technical problems during the play-offs in 1988, both teams were barred indefinitely from playing in the Danish league.

In 1993, through the efficient chairmanship of Fred Santos with the assistance of Onofre Garcia and coordination of the different managers and coaches, several teams of basketball enthusiasts joined the summer "Street Basketball" and the winter Intercolor Tournament which were both



carried out successfully.

The results of the seasonal play-offs were promising in terms of discipline and sportsmanship. This paved the way for the creation of a team, BC Manila, to compete in the tournaments of the KBBF (København Basketball Forbund), an opportunity being awaited for by our basketball fanatics in the Filipino community.

Currently, Sports Adviser Fred Acasio and Business Manager Teddy Cuevas are very optimistic in their hope that this ball game perpetuates.



Another popular sports that has earned FAD's full participation is bowling. Tournaments under the association's sports umbrella had been held since 1973. It was in 1976 that the Eagle Bowling Club was founded by Ben Garcia, Roger Hacinas, Manny Quinto and Mogens Bredahl.

The Eagle Bowling Club, which became independent in 1979, holds invitational tournaments at the Bryggens Bowling Center every year. Since 1985, coordination between the FAD and EBC has been existing. Awarding of trophies to the winners of the concluded tourney takes place during the annual celebration of Philippine independence.

Other sports activities engaged in by a number of afficionados in 1976 were chess, badminton, table tennis and marshal art under the chairmanship of Ben Alcaraz, Mogens Bredahl and Einer Lyduch respectively.

The Officers' Night. November was a month to remember in 1994. The administration of four-time President Marc. R. Dicay initiated and hosted Salusalo Night '94, a humble reunion of all the FAD officers. The project was designed to fully appreciate the former officers who in one way or another had helped in building the Filipino community.



officers to reaffirm their fidelity to the association and to renew their commitment to its collective purpose.

The Newsletter. The FAD Info of today is a flourishing publication with 17 staffers, all of whom devote a portion of their time to its constant improvement. The end result is a paper that is both informative and entertaining. This article, with a glimpse into its past, shows the decisions and innovations that shaped and modified the FAD Info into what it is now, and in so doing ties this in to the development of the Filipino Association of Denmark.

Firstly known as the FAD Newsletter, the official organ began life in February 1979 under the watchful eyes of the then President Marc. R. Dicay and Editor-in-Chief Ben B. Garcia. With Flor Alvizo, Luz Diño, John Blix, Gaudie Caluza, Oscar Navarro and Manny Quinto gracing the newsletter pages, the publication appeared in newspaper make-up highlighting the most important stories in front. Its coverage included Community and Philippine news, Social tid-bits, Catholic corner, Sports and Milestone in the columnar method of arrangement.

The FAD Newsletter did not follow a definite timetable that its circulation was sporadic. November 1983 marked the release of its last issue.

the FAD Newsletter, INFO was circulated monthly. Its contents were mostly circulars, memos, announcements and Dicay during his 1979-82 administration.

other information that needed immediate dissemination. It existed until 1982.

The first ever annual was a two-in-one package dubbed as FOCUS which showcased a collage of people in action sharing the limelight of Circa '80.

Due to some ambiguous reasons, INFO had a refill of its pen in 1984 and in 1987-88. INFO was re-created and was improved with the election of Benigno Adriatico as PRO in 1985.

From 1989 to 1992, INFO came to fore again under President-elect Benigno Adriatico. He maintained the size of the newsletter but did some alterations on the first page converting it to the magazine type. The publication's name was placed vertically on the upper right corner of the back

However, this format was judged less than ideal in The reunion also served as an opportunity for all the 1993. Under the concerted endeavor of Onofre B. Garcia (Editor-in-Chief), Deng A. Valera (Associate Editor) and Marc. R. Dicay (Managing Editor), the size and the format of the newsletter have been reverted to where it started 14 years ago. It has gone back to the columnar method of arrangement.

> First in its history, Oscar Navarro's commentary, In Retrospect, became a regular column; Sa Wikang Sariling Atin marked the formalization of a Filipino section; and literary articles were given room in the publication.

> Nineteen-ninety-three was a significant year for the newsletter, for it was then that it assumed another identity. Due to some problems in the mailing, its name INFO was changed to its present flag FAD Info.

> In January 1995, Onofre B. Garcia has relinquished the editorial desk to Deng A. Valera who will remain Editor-in-Chief until December 1996. The less wasted space of the publication has proven worthy of reading that it has earned for itself the constant patronage of the avid readers.

With the 17 staffers at hand, the FAD Info intends to maintain the balance among the different sections of the newsletter and to continue its mission and vision of responsible journalism.

The Award. To give due recognition to the members Meantime, President Marc. R. Dicay came out in who dedicated their time and effort to the service of the 1980 with another publication entitled INFO. In contrast to Filipino Association of Denmark and the Filipino community as a whole, an award program was initiated by Marc. R.
